## Summative Mini Project

<u>Directions</u>: Create a summative project in which you demonstrate your understanding of the text:Choose <u>ONE</u> of the choices below:

- 1. <u>Debate:</u> Choose one side to prepare claims and evidence you will provide *(from your own experience and the text of "Two Kinds"):* Children today face too much pressure from their parents to excel in extracurricular activities. <u>OR</u> Children today should take advantage of the opportunities that they have and work hard to make their parents proud.
- 2. Write a script... in which you create a conversation between the narrator in the story and her mother. Have them discuss what is "fair" or "unfair" in terms of being "anything you wanted to be in America" (261). Does every child in America have equal opportunities to succeed and truly become whatever they want? Explain your answer within the script, but make sure the characters' attitudes in your script mirror their feelings in the text.
- 3. **Challenge:** Develop and perform a short monologue based on a scene from the story. You may prepare a monologue that reveals the narrator's, the mother's, or another character's inner thoughts and feelings. Write a script of the character's words and present your monologue to the class.
- 4. <u>Organize and implement a formal debate...</u> about immigration in the United States today using arguments, evidence, and illustrations generated from studying the unit text <u>and</u> your personal knowledge and/or experience. You may want to do some research for this assignment.
- 5. Compose a script and use it to create a presentation... via Google Slides, MovieMaker, or any other type of multimedia resource to present your audience with an immigration narrative, an explication of immigration issues or border crossing in US culture today, or an analysis of a cultural conflict (Burns & Botzakis, 2012).
